### Respite care and short breaks

All meals are freshly prepared by our on-site cooks and you can choose from a wide range of nutritious menus. We take the time to understand individual food preferences and snacks are always available.





We cater to individual spiritual needs, requests and beliefs and we can arrange for ministers of any faith to pay regular visits on request.



We have a number of volunteers who visit residents and arrange activities and outings throughout the year.

## End of life care

We are accredited with the Gold Standards Framework Programme. Where appropriate our staff are trained in delivering excellent end of life care with the support of local GPs and the District Nurse Team.

#### To find Little Bramingham Farm

From the A6: take Icknield Way to the first roundabout, turn onto Newbold Road, follow to the roundabout, turn left, LBF is approx 300m on your right.

From the M1: leave motorway at J11, take the A505 towards Dunstable. At the traffic lights, turn right onto Lewsey Road. At the traffic lights turn right onto Leagrave High Street, follow this road to the next set of traffic lights then bear left onto Grange Avenue. Go straight across the next lights and under the rail bridge. Straight over the big roundabout onto Bramingham Road, follow this road straight over two mini roundabouts, at the third, bear left onto Icknield Way.
